CHILD NUTRITION MANAGEMENT

The Board considers the practice of serving food at school primarily a convenience for parents, children, and school management; secondarily as a means of encouraging good health habits.

The school system will operate a school breakfast and lunch program in each school, which will be under the supervision of the Food Service Director.

The child nutrition staff in each school will be directly responsible to the Food Service Director, but will cooperate with the principal of the school in matters essential to the proper functioning of the food services program. The responsibility for control of students using the cafeteria will rest with the building principal, who may assign appropriate staff to provide supervisory control.

Child Nutrition will provide breakfast, lunch and ala carte items in accordance to federal guidelines.

The Board will approve the prices set for school breakfast and lunches and the price of milk.

PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS

As required for participation in the School Breakfast Program and National School Lunch Program, the Board agrees to the following regulations:

1. A reimbursable breakfast or lunch will be made available to all students.
2. That free or reduced price reimbursable breakfast or lunch will be provided to students whose households qualify for such.

Students will be permitted to bring a breakfast or lunch from home in accordance with the Peanut/Tree Nut Policy.
