FREE AND REDUCED PRICE FOOD SERVICES

The District will take part, as feasible, in the School Breakfast Program and National School Lunch Program and other food programs that may become available to see that all children in the District receive proper nourishment.

As required by law and regulations of the Federal Government, the Board will offer free and reduced price lunches to those qualifying children. In accordance with the charging policies set by the Board for each building, students will be allowed three (3) consecutive alternative meals after which the District will not be responsible for providing a meal until the terms of the charging policy is met.

The Superintendent will establish regulations that conform with requirements for participation in programs for free and reduced price meals and supplementary food. Such regulations will be reported to the Board as needed for its approval.

All financial records of these programs will be kept in a separate account by the Business Manager.
