ADVANCED COLLEGE PLACEMENT

Advanced placement courses may be offered by the district provided a sufficient number of students request a particular course and qualify for it, and that a qualified staff member is available to instruct the course.

Students in advanced placement courses are not required to enroll for college credit in the course. Each advanced placement course is a .5 high school credit per semester with a passing grade. College crediting is left to the protocol of the host site. Students bear the burden of tuition and fees and must be aware of and meet host site deadlines for enrollment. Harrisburg High School bears no responsibility for procedures for enrollment for college credit. This includes but is not limited to: minimum earned grade for credit, required communication with on-site instructor, extra assignments, etc.

If a particular course is not offered by the district, a qualified high school student may enroll in a college-level course offered either on-site or online by an approved and accredited college or university. The guidance office may provide scheduling assistance if necessary. On-line or on-site courses are also credited on the high school transcript as .5 per semester with a passing grade.

The guidance office maintains a complete list of advanced placement opportunities from accredited local and regional colleges and universities.
